

UPPER COUGAR CREEK

Survey #1

The City of Sunset Valley is moving forward with a design process for Upper Cougar Creek, the open space at the intersection of Brodie Lane and Ernest Robles Way. The Upper Cougar Creek property is unique with about 75% in the floodplain and the design will balance recreation opportunities with improving water quality. This site has previously undergone a concept design in 2021 and also was part of the 2022 Parks and Open Space Master Plan.
