Storage Yard Access

Residents can access the gated Storage Yard behind City Hall for approved materials.

Key Information:

- Open daily: 7:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m.
 - 1 keycard per residence
- Up to 24 visits per calendar year
- No hazardous waste, commercial waste, electronics, tires, or construction debris

WASTEWATER AVERAGING

Wastewater averaging begins in December and runs through the month of February. Customers are encouraged to turn off outdoor irrigation systems. Wastewater averages determine your wastewater volumetric rate for the remainder of the year. Please conserve water during this time period to lower your monthly utility rate.



Customer Assistance Program



The City has updated the requirements for the Customer Assistance Program. Residential customers on low or fixed incomes who participate in certain state, federal, or local assistance programs can benefit from the City of Sunset Valley's Customer Assistance Program (CAP) utility bill discounts. CAP Utility Bill Discounts can help reduce water, wastewater, solid waste, and drainage utility fees by 50%. To learn more and apply for this program, please use the QR code to the left.




BACKFLOW TESTING



Many customers may have received a letter notifying them of the need to have their backflow device tested. Backflow devices come in many forms and are connected to irrigation systems, rainwater harvesting tanks, and even large ice machines. These devices prevent water from potentially hazardous sources from flowing back into the public water system. Testing of these devices helps to prevent cross connection and protects the Public Water System

If you have received a notification your backflow needs to be tested and submitted online through SC Tracking. You can find a service provider by using the QR code to the left. Make sure to choose Sunset Valley for your jurisdiction.

EYE ON WATER

The majority of residential customers have access to monitor their daily water use through the Eye on Water app. You can sign up by using the QR code to the right and only need your account number to sign up. You can also set up leak alerts so you will know as early as possible to reduce water loss.
