

**CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT
RESOLUTION NO. 062221**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF SUNSET VALLEY CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2021 TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE DISTRICT; ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the voters in November 2016, by a majority of the persons voting, previously created the City of Sunset Valley Crime Control and Prevention District for a five-year term, and voted to create a Crime Control and Prevention District sales tax; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunset Valley Crime Control and Prevention District will expire unless reauthorized by the voters of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the City of Sunset Valley Crime Control and Prevention District is authorized under Texas Local Government Code Section 363.251(b) to order a referendum on continuation of the district by majority vote; and

WHEREAS, the uniform election date is November 2, 2021 and the holding of the Crime Control and Prevention District continuation election simultaneously with the city election will reduce the cost to taxpayers of such election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF SUNSET VALLEY CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT THAT:

**SECTION 1.
ELECTION ORDERED; DATE**

A referendum is hereby ordered to be held on the November 2, 2021, from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. with early voting as provided herein and as provided by law, wherein the eligible voters residing within the City of Sunset Valley Crime Control and Prevention District shall be permitted to vote for or against the following proposition:

" Whether the City of Sunset Valley Crime Control and Prevention District should be continued for five (5) years and the crime control and prevention district sales tax should be continued for five (5) years."

**SECTION 2.
JOINT ELECTION**

Such election shall be held jointly with the City's General and Special Elections conducted along with and by Travis County.

**SECTION 3.
CONDUCT OF ELECTION**

Travis County Elections Administrator, 5501 Airport Boulevard, Austin, TX 78751-1410 shall conduct and shall be the clerk for early voting of said election for the District. The City Secretary of the City of Sunset Valley, 3205 Jones Rd., Sunset Valley, TX 78745 shall serve as deputy early voting clerk for the County along with any additional designees. The election shall be conducted according to the Texas Election Code and the Texas Constitution.

**SECTION 4.
EARLY VOTING**

Early voting, both by personal appearance and by mail, will be conducted by the City Secretary, who is hereby designated and appointed as the Early Voting Clerk for the general election for City residents residing in Travis County in accordance with the *Texas Election Code*. Early Voting for the above designated election shall be at City Hall, 3205 Jones Rd., Sunset Valley, TX 78745. Early voting shall commence on Monday, October 18, 2021, and continue through Friday, October 29, 2021, and early voting polls shall remain open for the time specified by the *Texas Election Code*.

**SECTION 5.
ELECTION DAY LOCATION AND HOURS**

On November 2, 2021, Election Day, there shall be one (1) election precinct for the election, which shall contain and include all the geographic area within the City. The polling place for citizens of the Ward 1 of the City shall be the City Hall, 3205 Jones Rd., Sunset Valley, TX 78745. The polls shall remain open on the day of the election from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

**SECTION 6.
ADMINISTRATION AND PROCEDURES OF THE ELECTION**

The Board Chair of the District or the City Administrator of the City are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a joint election agreement for said election with Travis County, Texas and to execute such election agreement for said election. Such agreement will provide for the type of voting machines to be used for early voting and on Election Day, and the compensation for and appointment of election judges and clerks. The County Elections Administrators shall process the Early Voting Ballots, and other positions, appointments or requirements as required by law, and any other requirements or appointments necessary for the conduct of said election for and on behalf of the City. All election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.

**SECTION 7.
PERSONS QUALIFIED TO VOTE**

All residents who are qualified electors of the District shall be permitted to vote at said election. This election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code as may be required by law.


**SECTION 8.
NOTICE OF ELECTION**

Notice of the election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Resolution ordering an election in English and Spanish translations at City Hall on the official bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council and the District, and at a public place located within each election precinct in the District; a copy of this Resolution's caption shall also be published in English and Spanish translations in the District's official newspaper of general circulation published in the District.

**SECTION 9.
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

PASSED AND APPROVED on this the 22nd day of June 2021, by a vote of six (6) ayes, no nays, and no abstentions at a regular meeting of the Crime Control and Prevention District of the City of Sunset Valley, Texas.
